To raise awareness of climate change and sustainability, Beechwood Park has registered to join the online **Wild Wisdom Global Challenge 2022.** 

From 10th October, students can access an abundance of online resources to explore independently and learn more about key environmental issues. This year the focus is on Big Cat species and the integral role they play within their ecosystems. Using this knowledge, students will then take part in a series of quizzes, competing against schools all over the world. There are some fantastic prizes to be won, including a 'Big Cat Conservation' virtual webinar, with zoologists and experts in the field and a HarperCollins book bundle.

The Challenge requires students to register on the Challenge webpage from 3rd October

Step 1 - Students create a login on the Challenge webpage <u>itza.io</u> by picking a username and creating a password. If your child is aged 13 or under, they must give an email address for a parent or guardian in order to approve their account.

Step 2 - students use their school code to register for the Challenge

- Login to itza.io with login details
- Enter 6-digit school code AAABYF

- 10 minutes daily
- Students login and explore new content independently
- Students take part in fun quizzes to test their knowledge
- Help their school climb the leader- board!
